### VINTAGE SUMMARY

The season in Hawkes Bay was a roller coaster that finished with a flourish and provided the winery with some stunning fruit. The summer was excellent until February, when uncharacteristic cool weather set in, causing some concern amongst winemakers and viticulturists. But our fears were unfounded, as March turned on some exceptional hot and dry weather that carried right through April to the end of vintage.

### VINIFICATION

Premium Cabernet Sauvignon grapes were very gently pressed to yield a delicate and refined juice. Cool fermented to retain elegance, freshness and length.

### APPEARANCE

Pale salmon pink

### BOUQUET

Lifted aromas of rock melon, red currant, strawberry and creaming soda with a biscuity complexity.

### PALATE

Beautifully textured rich palate with silky qualities. A medley of flavours including guava, strawberry, red currant, tropical fruits and a creamy nougat texture.
