Tasting Notes

Lifted aromas of black pepper, vanilla, violets and ripe red berries. Very rich soft texture and full palate with fine and supple balanced tannins. Complex and mouthfilling wine with excellent varietal concentration and finesse.

Vintage Summary

A Warm Summer was followed by excellent autumn conditions. Fruit was harvested in pristine condition.

Vinification

Hand plunged in small open fermentors with an indigenous yeast ferment. Carefully and gently pressed to barrel for 12 months elevage in French oak.

Viticultural Detail

Crop thinned vines were hand leaf plucked and harvested.
