VINTAGE SUMMARY

The wines from the 2007 Marlborough vintage look fantastic. Clean pure flavours and aromas abound, ferments went extremely well and the regional characters Marlborough is famous for are in abundance. This applies to all varieties harvested including Sauvignon Blanc, Pinot Gris, Riesling, Chardonnay and Pinot Noir. The latter has excellent colour and structure, and wines in barrel are looking very promising.
