VINTAGE SUMMARY

Excellent warm summer conditions prevailed into the autumn ripening period.

VINIFICATION

Hand picked fruit was gently de-stemmed to small open fermenters. Following five days cold soak, a natural fermentation commenced. Gently pressed at dryness to French oak barriques for 16 months maturation.
