VINTAGE SUMMARY

Excellent vintage conditions prevailed allowing a great harvest of ripe and concentrated fruit.

VINIFICATION

Hand picked grapes were gently de-stemmed and fermented in small open vats with hand plunging. Age 12 months in French oak barriques.

Hand managed viticulture with shoot thinning, crop thinning and leaf plucking.
